## Technical informationen about NAWI Graz study programmes

- The necessary exchange of data between the universities to be able to administer jointly offered study programmes is basically organised via the [data alliance of universities according to § 18 University and College Statistics and Education Documentation Ordinance](#) (German only). Additional relevant data exchange takes place via the interface [AHESN](#).

## Main Page/AHESN

AHESN, the "Austrian Higher Education Systems Network" is an open, standardised, Austria-wide exchange format for data in the education sector and is used in teacher training and NAWI Graz studies, that are offered jointly by two or more universities/educational institutions.

This open interface is independent of the online system used by an educational institution.

The project AHESN defines and develops an interface for the coupling on system level. The digitally modelled common curriculum serves as a bracket for the exchange of the following data:

- Basic technical info
- Final thesis (currently information about the completed master thesis)
- Recognition
- Attendance count for exams
- Curriculum position
- Content bracket (=equivalent to the equality node across educational institutions)
- Course incl. course registration
- Examination course incl. examination date and examination registration
- individual performance record
- Studies (extension of existing data exchange e.g. reasons for termination of studies)

Students or teachers of NAWI Graz do not have to make any settings in order to use functionalities of AHESN, as this is done automatically on system level.

## Main Page/Legal Information/Statute on Study-Law

Basically, the statutes of [TU Graz](#) and [Uni Graz](#) apply to NAWI Graz studies. According to § 54e Abs. 3 University Act, the rectortates determine which provision of which university is to be applied in case of unequal provisions of the statutes on study law. This regulation has been published textdident by [Uni Graz](#) und [TU Graz](#) in their university newsletter:

For **NAWI Graz studies the following applies in principle:**

- For all topics concerning the **admission to studies, recognitions and the master thesis, the responsibility always lies with the admitting university.** *Example: The topic of the master thesis is always registered with the responsible dean's office of the admitting university.*
- For all topics concerning a **specific examination, course or the Bachelor's thesis, the responsibility always lies with the university offering the course or examination in question.** *Example: Registration for a board examination always takes place at the university that offers this examination date.*

Which group of person gets which type of account?

- **Staff members** receive their electronic identity in the online system of the university to which the employment relationship exists. In addition, they can apply for an account in the system of the partner university directly at the NAWI Graz institute ([list](#)), which is the counterpart to their own institute in terms of subject, or which is close to their own institute in terms of subject, or with which there are collaborations. If there is no direct contact to this institute, the best way to ask for an account is to send an email to the email address of the institute stored in the online system. For the creation of the account, the social security number is required (to exclude that a person is created more than once) and the postal address of the institute.
- If you have applied for an account, you will receive an email with the PIN for the activation. Follow these instructions.
- **Recommendations:**
  - With every new account an email address is generated in the online system of this university. You can either [include this email address in your email client](#) (and use a combined mailbox) or create a forwarding to your mail address. This is possible for mail addresses at the University of Graz at [emailforward.uni-graz.at](mailto:emailforward.uni-graz.at) and for mail addresses at the TU Graz in [Outlook WebAccess](#).
  - By this you ensure that you receive all email (especially notifications about passwords renewal) in your email client.
    - *Ask the Institute at the partner university to link the business card of their online system with the business card of your "home university's" system. 


### Overview

The function inter-university exam registration enables NAWI Graz students to call up all exam dates of both universities in an online system and to register or deregister directly there.

### Guide to set\up the inter\university exam registration

1. Log into one of the two systems ([online.uni-graz.at](http://online.uni-graz.at) oder [online.tugraz.at](http://online.tugraz.at)) and go to personal settings. The examples shows how to do so in TUGRAZonline.

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## **Main Page/Organisational Information for NAWI GRAZ Teachers and Administrators/Communicating with all students and teachers in a course**

(Laboratory) courses are held in NAWI Graz studies in groups at both universities. There is the case that a teacher acts as a coordinator and wants to communicate directly from one online system with all students and teachers. This is possible if all groups of this course including teachers and dates are set up at one university. This would have to be considered accordingly in the teacher survey. In any case, an alternating course on an annual basis should be planned.

## Main Page/Technical-organisational peculiarities/Private Cloud

Both universities offer their students free use of the university's internal cloud instances. The servers are operated at the locations of the respective universities and are also used for teaching purposes.

Students can share files between the instances of the universities if the personal *Federated Cloud ID* is used for this purpose. If necessary, this ID must be exchanged manually for data protection reasons.

## Main Page/Technical-organisational peculiarities/Student Card

Although both universities use the same technology of Mifare chip cards, the data of the reading devices at the doors between the universities are not synchronised for reasons of data protection.

NAWI Graz students receive a Student Card from the admitting university. If it is necessary to grant access to locked rooms of the respective other university (e.g. in the context of the master thesis), this is done as follows - if no conventional physical keys are used:

- Uni Graz-approved students can get a TU Graz student card at the [registrar's office of TU Graz](#) and the locking authorisation for TU Graz rooms will be installed there.
- TU Graz-approved students install the [YOUNI app](#) on their Android device or Iphone and the locking authorisation is then done via it.
